

Disturbing Facts on John Fetterman

- John Fetterman is on video supporting the release of one-third of Pennsylvania's prison population, saying it won't make anyone "less safe."
- John Fetterman has advocated for decriminalizing all drugs including heroin, meth, and fentanyl.
- John Fetterman has called for defunding the police by taking away the protective equipment they use to keep our communities safe.
- John Fetterman supports eliminating life sentences for murder.
- John Fetterman voted for pardons for two convicted-murderers (Dennis and Lee Horton) who now work on his campaign, and he voted to pardon another convicted-murderer that now works in his taxpayer-funded office (George Trudel).

Should border security be enforced?	Yes. Dr. Oz believes a secure border is critical in maintaining our core identity as a country and in fighting crime.	No. The current Fetterman administration encourages "ghost flights" into PA: unknown migrants are flown into PA and bused to unknown locations. How many MS-13 criminals come in that way?
Should the private sector be empowered to provide health care?	Yes. With his extensive medical background, Dr. Oz understands the drawbacks of government-administered health care, and will work to promote private-sector, inexpensive alternatives.	No. Fetterman supports complete government take-over of health care, no matter the waste, cost and complete control over our lives and deaths.
Should heavy regulations on drilling and fracking for natural gas in PA be overturned?	Yes. PA is a leader in the production of natural gas and coal, and should be freed from Biden's regulatory attacks. We don't need to be paying high prices at the pump or at the food stores.	No. In the name of "climate change," Fetterman wants to eliminate resource development, even though PA's abundant natural gas will allow PA's "forgotten places" to prosper.
Should the military be defunded?	No. Dr. Oz believes in peace through strength to keep the world safe and to support our allies.	Yes. Fetterman advocates slashing the defense budget, lifting "maximum pressure" sanctions on Iran, and for the US to lead the way in abolishing nuclear weapons, leaving US vulnerable to rogue nations.
